MANUAL FOR THE USE OF THE DRAWERPROPS GARDEN DRILL BIT

INDICATIONS FOR INTENDED USE

Garden auger bits are designed for drilling holes in the ground and are compatible with 3/8' or larger chuck drills.

They are useful for:

- 1) Soil Drilling: Ideal for Drilling Holes in Soft Ground for Planting Trees, Shrubs or Flowers.
- 2) Post Insertion: Facilitates the Creation of Holes to Install Fence Posts and Fence Posts, Ensuring a Firm Base.
- 3) Gardening Projects: Useful for Preparing Soil Before Planting as it Allows Soil, Substrate, Fertiliser and Seeds to be Mixed Easily Allowing Better Aeration and Drainage.
- 4) Other Uses: Digging Hole in the Sand to Anchor your Beach Umbrella, Creating Holes for Setting up Tents, Paint Mixer and Mixing Batches.

They are manufactured from Manganese Steel which gives the following properties and characteristics:

- 1) High resistance to wear and abrasion.
 - 2) High hardness and a remarkable capacity to absorb impacts without fracturing.
 - 3) Improves the toughness of the material and gives it a greater capacity to resist plastic deformation under compressive stresses.
 - 4) Work hardening capability, which means that, under stress conditions, manganese steel can become harder over time.
- Two sizes are available: 2.6' x 16.5' (6.6x42 cm) and 3.9' x 16' (10x40 cm). Not recommended for use in areas with many roots or stones.

SELECTION AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Choose the right size of drill bit for the hole you wish to drill.
- 2) Choose the right length for the depth of the hole.
- 3) Ensure that the chuck is 3/8' or larger.
- 4) Place and secure the drill bit in the drill according to the manufacturer's instructions.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Keep drill bits out of the reach of children.
2. Wear personal protective equipment (goggles, gloves, ear muffs, face mask).
3. Apply proper drilling pressure to avoid wear or ineffective drilling.
4. Do not touch the drill bit or the ground until the drill bit has come to a complete stop.

MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS

1. Clean and lubricate the drill bit after use.
 2. Store the drill bit in a dry and clean place.
- Check the condition of the bit before each use and replace it if it is worn or damaged.
